Background

Jim joined Reading Electric in 2008 as General Manager with the primary objective of expanding the company, founded by his Great Uncle, into new business markets. In this role, he re-organized the company into Business Units and personally developed the unit focused on Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy.
